Ms. Stanford reported to the Board that two garbage haulers, Billy Drake and Earth Friends, were not in compliance with the contract between the hauler and county. Motion was made by Supervisor George to give the haulers until July 16, 2012 to come into compliance and if the haulers were not in compliance at that date, their permits would be revoked. Motion was seconded by Supervisor Selmon and carried unanimously to give additional time to come into compliance.

Following transaction of the above matters, the Board began equalization of the 2012 Real and Personal Property Rolls.
