Order of the Board of Supervisors

Re: Real and Personal Property Assessment Rolls

The Board immediately at its July 8, 2009 meeting proceeded to equalize the 2009 Real and Personal Property Assessment Rolls and the said rolls having been equalized, according to law, are ready for inspection and examination.
